Being in the heart of the city centre, means the easiest, most convenient way of reaching us is by public transport.

We are about 10 minutes walk from Piccadilly, Victoria, Oxford Road and Deansgate railway stations. The Metrolink shuttle bus number 1 that runs between each of these stations every 10 minutes or so does drop off and pick up on King Street opposite the college.

Piccadilly Gardens and Shudehill bus stations are within 5 minutes walk from the college with the tram stops of Mosley Street, Market Street and St Peter's Square even closer.

Driving in is straightforward but please note that there are no on-site car parking facilities at the college. However, there is street parking available and there are several car parks within a few minutes walk of our front door.
